## Promoting biodiversity protection through innovative and health orientated nature-based activities in Alpine Protected Areas

Hotspots for biodiversity, tourism & outdoor activities - how do they go together? A challenge for the Alpine Protected Areas (APA) covering 30 % of the Alpine territory.

Ecologically fragile alpine sites are exposed to overcrowding and nature-based activities (NBA), which impact species by fragmenting or destroying their habitats and disturbing their reproduction phases. Biodiversity loss from nature-based activities, a trend observed across the Alps, requires region-wide solutions. LiveAlpsNature analyses the impact of nature-based activities on alpine biodiversity, develops innovative biodiversity-friendly solutions for NBA and then directly implements, assesses & enhances the NBA solutions in Alpine Protected Areas and beyond.

By involving local stakeholders, LiveAlpsNature addresses the increase in tourism by guiding long-term behavioural changes to reduce impacts on biodiversity and create sustainable nature-based activities.
